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**Infants and Toddlers  
(Ages: 0-4 yrs)**

Experienced & professional childcare is available each Sunday during worship services, after service activities and for congregational events. Sensory friendly activities, music, books, toys, games, simple crafts and free play are offered.



Our staff is First Aid & CPR certified. We follow childcare policies mandated by state laws and *Unitarian Universalist Association* guidelines.



## Maker Space & Mover Space

(K-8<sup>th</sup> grade)

Each Sunday, children will choose between the Maker space and the Mover space. Following the monthly themes and using the weekly story, the workshops are designed to engage children through our values and their own interests.



Our *UUCB Maker Space* challenges will encourage children to work on projects that are real and personally meaningful and connected to our monthly themes.

Our *UUCB Mover Space* is based on principles of Odyssey of the mind that allows children to express themselves or the idea challenged to them through dance, drama, or other means.

## Youth Group

**9th Grade through 12th Grade**

Our program for youth has a flexible format to respond to the needs and interests of the group. The youth, with the guidance of their *Advisors*, will determine the shape & focus of their meetings & activities for the year. The group incorporates the following six aspects of youth programming: youth leadership development, worship, social justice & social action, fellowship & fun; and, education & learning.



Youth are encouraged to participate in congregational and district-wide activities, including the Youth-Adult Committee, multigenerational worship, regional youth conferences, Holiday Events and themed parties.
